

Minutes  
Regular Council Meeting  
June 8, 1987 7:00pm

Present: Mayor Alton Cumbie, Councilman Henry Law, Clarence Phillips, "Doc" Evatt  
Frank Chaka, Harry Holladay, Troy Porter at work, Olin Gambrell, Lynn Warnock.

Meeting called to order by Frank Chaka.

Invocation by Mr. Holladay.

Minutes read for the May 11, 1987; May 26, 1987; May 29, 1987 and June 4, 1987 meetings. Motion for acceptance by Mr. Law, Second by Mr. Phillips. Vote Unanimous.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mr. Law-- gave the Police Report. Also reported to Council the progress with Junior Mann stating that Mr. Mann had been arrested. In addition Mr. Law made known that the property is not owned by Mr. Mann but by Atlantic Properties.

Mr. Chaka-- gave Financial Report. Mr. Gambrell presented letter that is to go to Mr. Steer about Sewer going through the system. Discussion of Sewer "Dumps" going into our system from Central Textiles.

Mr. Porter--Absent

Mr. Phillips--Requested to know progress on Hardee's Sewer. Mr. Gambrell reported that they will be coming in on the 15th of this month to dig the hole and put in the pump.

Mr. Holladay--Question on testing of the system before Hardee's is in business. Mr. Gambrell stated that it would be tested and approved before going into business. Mr. Evatt-- NONE

NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. Law-- Made Council aware of a number of fishing poles, reels, a depth finder, 2 irons found by prisoners in the dumpsters at Regency Apartments. At the time it was found Ralph Webb was told that if no one claimed these items and they were not stolen he could have them back. Mr. Porter had made his complaints known to Mr. Law. Discussion on situation. Discussion about Scavenging through the trash. Not Permitted. Decision to hold till next work session.

Mr. Chaka: Need to start working on the new budget. Decision to have Second Reading on Annexation on Monday work session. "Doc" Evatt stating that he could not be present at that time.

Mr. Porter--Absent. Mr. Gambrell noted that Tee-Ball is now over and Day Camp starts on Monday. Motion by Mr. Holladay to close park at 9:00pm in the summer and 8:00pm in the winter. Second by Mr. Law. Vote Unanimous.

Mr. Phillips-- Made known complaints on bad service from Cable and HBO.

Mr. Holladay--Question on more properties for annexation. Interested in Duke Power. Mr. Gambrell noted that Duke Power is not interested in annexation unless American House of Spinning agrees also. Mr. Law also requested something be done about the John Hunt house; bad yard condition. Mayor also suggested that something be done about the Roller Mill and the adjoining building.

Mr. Evatt-- NONE

Mayor's Report:

Sigma System; wants \$1100 to install the system with a saving of \$700.00 a year. Mr. Holladay made motion to give Sigma System a try. Second by Mr. Law. Vote Unanimous. Discussion of Junior Mann situation and who actually owns the land. Mr. Gambrell requested by the Mayor to check on the legalities of towing these cars of this property.

Motion for Executive Session by Mr. Chaka, Second by Mr. Law. Vote Unanimous.
