## TOWN COUNCIL MEETING June 9, 1975

Present: Fowler, Hopkins, Busha, Porter, Kennemore, St. Supt. - John Head, Chief of Police - Harold Duncan, and Clerk - Catherine Hughes.

Mayor Protem Fowler called meeting to order. Question of valve at water tank was brought before Council. Council gave approval to go ahead if repair or parts were needed.

Chief brought before the Council question of overtime for Police Dept. and asked that the Council let him know what they decided. Porter suggested to table this matter until Police Comm. talk with Chief and work out something. Will present to Council at a later date.

Motion by Thompson and 2nd by Fowler to approve CMP Grant for summer.

St. Supt. John Head states plan to start opening ditches.

Motion by Thompson, 2nd by Fowler to send a certified letter of 30 days notice to La Vista Apts. concerning 1973 tax notice and sewer taps or sewerage would be disconnected.

Also certified letter to Easley Plumbing & Heating concerning sewer for CNB. Same 30 day limit. Council approved.

Note to Council: S. C. State Retirement increase 5.95 over 5.65.

Note to Council: Myer's Const. states if Town will break up and haul away present sidewalk, bank will furnish a new one.

John stated that Brock wants a line run through his pasture of 1500 to 2000 ft. Brock will furnish pipe and meter if Town will furnish labor.

Motion by Porter, 2nd by Fowler that the Revenue Sharing Planning use report for entitlement period July 1, 1975 - June 30, 1976 be accepted as read. Council approved.

Motion by Porter, 2nd by Thompson that Wallace Palmer be refunded a business license for a juke box in which he was unable to use because State wouldn't issue a state license. Refund \$20.00. Council approved.

John asked Council about overtime hours for St. Dept. Council says give time off for overtime.


Chief stated to Council that on June 19th they would go to Columbia to protest Beer license for Ray's Recreation.


Fowler okay's water supplies: 6 joints of 8" pipe, 2000 ft. of 2" pipe
