

Regular Council Meeting
June 10, 1991 7:00 P. M.

Mayor Cumbie called the meeting to order.

Invocation by Harry Holladay.

Minutes of the May 13, 1991 meeting were read. After corrections, Frank Chaka made a motion to accept, this was seconded by Stan Thompson. Vote was unanimous.

Mayor Cumbie gave second reading on the ordinance to annex Garvin and Doris Madden property into the Town of Central. Motion by Frank Chaka, second by "Doc" Evatt to accept the ordinance. Vote was unanimous.

Stan Thompson - Mr. Thompson noted that the fire referendum would be held on June 11, 1991. After the referendum Mr. Thompson inquired as to whether the town should take the initiative and invite the public in to show what we have available in services for the fire department. After discussion consensus of council for Stan and John Head to come up with a plan for this idea.

Frank Chaka Gave the financial report. Budget should be at 67% and is on target.

Administrator's report:
