

Minutes of June 22, 1981  
Central Town Council Meeting

Present: Mayor Summey; Mayor Pro-Tem Chaka; Mr. Porter; Mr. Rampey; Mr. Gambrell

Also Present; Administrator Ellers

In addition: Terry Creegar-Messenger

At 7:00 p. m., the revenue-sharing hearing commenced. The revenue-sharing budget was presented; there were no comments.

At 7:25, the regular meeting commenced. The Administrator presented his report. He noted that the Jeep vehicle was no longer in operation. The Mayor gave a detailed report on condition of the vehicle. The Mayor and Administrator were asked to check on the possibility of a second-hand vehicle. No formal action was taken.

The Administrator stated the possibility of converting two vehicles to propane on a trial basis at no cost. There was some favorable discussion but no formal action was taken.

Mr. Rampey stated the need for a policy on take-home of vehicles. Mr. Chaka requested a work session to formulate a policy on vehicles.

The Administrator stated that at a future date, the State Deferred Compensation Plan would be presented for Council's study. He also presented a request from Peyton Moore to Annex an area on the east side of Town. Request was accepted as information.

The second reading of the election ordinance was passed. Motion made by Mr. Chaka; second Gambrell to adopt-vote unanimous.

The clean-up ordinance was adopted on second-reading. Motion by Mr. Gambrell ; second Rampey to adopt-vote unanimous.

Mr. Chaka asked for a discussion of water/sewer rates. There was much discussion. Mr. Chaka's main concern was that the public be informed.

Motion by Mr. Chaka; second by Mr. Porter to adopt the budget and resolutions vote unanimous.

The Mayor stated that he was looking at ways to track down water losses. Motion by Mr. Chaka to adjourn; second by Mr. Rampey.
