The Town Council met Thursday night, July 2, 1964, with the following attending: Mayor J.A. Cranford, Councilmen C.B. Bryan, R.A. Busha, J.L. Martin, W.J. Wilson, Mrs. Maude Chapman and Dough Mauldin reporters for the Greenville News and Messenger were also present.

Mayor Cranford presided. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Annexation of property owned by Miss Amanda Patterson, Earl Crane and A.R. Cureton was discussed. The Council agreed to talk further with property owners before making any decision on this. The Mayor and Town Council decided to meet with property owners on Tuesday, July 14th at 6:00 P.M. for further discussion.

A discussion was held on the water works' supt. being allowed to have a weeks vacation without no responsibilities of his regular duties. Mr. Wilson made a motion that Golden be given this vacation. Mr. Busha seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

The Council agreed to get bids from Sears Roebuck Co. and Allison Co. for fence at sewage disposal.


Sewage problem near Heyward Brooks home was discussed, but no action taken.

Mr. Cranford stated that Mr. Cumbie had been working on maps for the Town and would be finished soon.


The Council discussed having Town Ordinances printed in Book Form, but no action taken.
