

Regular Council Meeting July 8, 1985

Mayor Cumbie called the meeting to order.
Invocation by Harry Holladay.

Minutes of the June 10, 1985 meeting were read. Motion by Harry Holladay, second by "Doc" Evatt to approve as read. Vote unanimous.

OLD BUSINESS:

Henry Law (at work) Mr. Gambrell noted water line work on Johnson Road to begin July 10, contracts have been approved.

Frank Chaka--gave police report. Noted police contract problems being researched for later report.

Troy Porter--Discussed water drainage on Wood St. to get with Mr. Frankovich and see what can be done to correct the problem. Mr. Gambrell reported that old water tank support had been removed.

Mayor Cumbie noted that files for Robert Newton and Peyton Moore had been turned over to Attorney Pick Lindsay since the 15 days given for compliance had not been carried out. "Doc" Evatt--sign regulations need to be looked in to.
