The Town Council met Monday night, July 10, 1961, with the following attending: Mayor, S.C. Carson, Councilmen, C.B. Bryan, W.J. Wilson, R.A. Busha, J.J. Canup, J.A. Cranford and Mr. Bill McClellan of Clemson.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. Mayor Darson presided.


A discussion was held on the garbage pick-up. Mr. Bill McClellan was present to discuss taking over the garbage pick-up for two months. After the Councilmen had heard Mr. McClellan's plans for the next two months, which included picking up the garbage in the residential sections once a week and in the business area twice a week, sweeping the streets twice a week, Mr. Wilson made a motion that Mr. McClellan be hired to do this work at the rate of \$400.00 per month. Mr. Bryan seconded the motion. The council agreed.

A barbecue chicken supper was planned for the Town officials and invited guest on Tuesday night, August 1st., at the City Park

The Council agreed to sign the contract to have Business License checked.


