## Council Regular Meeting July 11, 1977 Minutes

Those Present: Kennemore, Hopkins, Rollins, Boyles, Porter, Mayor Holladay, Bethea, St. Superintendent John Head, Clerk & Treas. Catherine Hughes, Chief of Police Duncan & Melvin Brooks.

Minutes of the last council meeting were read and approved as read.

Mayor Holladay asked Porter if he had met with the School Trustee's concerning the (Old School Building). Porter stated he had talked with Collins and he in turn was to talk to Earl & Nash and be back in touch with him. As of this date Collins had not been back in touch with Porter.

Bethea stated that he had been in touch with Emma Kelley concerning property for BOR Grant to build a football, softball field.

Bethea stated the Town of Central was placed back on the priority list for the I/I Grant.

Motion by Kennemore seconded by Porter to accept a resolution from the South Carolina State Housing Authority in the Town of Central for(8 or 9 units low income & elderly).

Police Dept.: Kennemore stated he felt that Gilstrap should have patrolman pay. No action taken.

Mayor Holladay asked Bethea to get in touch with the Town Attorney concerning Business License at Calvin Mann Automative Research who has not purchased license for the 1977 year.

Melvin Brooks thanked the Town Council for the cooperation that was given last year concerning Hill Billy Day and St. Dance for the Shriners Hospital. Asked the Council for approval of another Hill Billy Day & St. Dance to be Aug. 27, 1977. Council approved


Parks & Recreation: Mrs. Boyles stated that a slab of concrete placed across the branch needs lifted or filled in and replaced.
