Note: Report from Recreation Dept. that there was \$533.00 made on the 10 speed bicycle donated by Central Concrete, also \$733.00 less light expense from the softball tournament. Porter stated that their was to be another tournament and made a **motion that all money from the tournament go to Central Recreation Dept. then transferred to General Fund Acct. Hopkins second the motion. Motion carried.

Kennemore made a motion that the Town not to take the maintenance agreement with Motorola on the Police Communication Equipment, seconded by Porter. Motion carried. (\$97.00 month)

Motion by Thompson second by Hopkins to mark of \$51.74 as bad debts from water customers who left outstanding accts. Motion carried.

Mayor Pro-tem Fowler read a letter from the Future Leaders of Central in regards to our Tennis Courts. Due to the fact they were built with Federal Grants we are to put up signs that governs the time a person plays, also we are to check with other Towns in our area to see how they handle this problem.

Mayor Pro-Tem read the amount we have in General Fund as of July 14, '75.

Fowler gave a report on sewer pipe @ .39 ft. with joints. Porter made a motion if it equals to what we are use to buying to get the pipe. Second by Hopkins. Motion carried.

Mike Perry policeman ask what to do with overtime, also stated no Parking Signs at ball park on Highway 93: and a radar sign be placed down in front of the Dee Mart.

Fire Dept. made a request for Town Maintenance crew to clear up around Fire Hydrant.

Motion made by Jack Kennemore to ask Chief Duncan for his resignation & give him a two week notice. Motion died from lack of a second.

Porter & Kennemore wants a call meeting for July 21, 1975 7:00 PM for the purpose of salaries for all employees.

The Mayor of Norris asked Porter about renting the Central Police Radar Unit. Motion made by Porter to rent our Radar for \$5.00 a day to Norris, second by Thompson. Motion carried.
