Regular Council Meeting

Meeting called to order by Mayor Summey. Mr. Henry Law with the Central Hillbilly Club was recognized. He asked for a reduced license fee on the amusement vendor to possibly enable the Hillbilly Club to get a larger share of the profits to donate to charity.

Motion by Mr. Chaka; second by Mr. Evatt to grant a license fee of \$50.00 if the Hillbilly Club splits the profits 50/50 with the vendor. Motion unanimously approved. (Mr. Gambrell abstained from discussion and voting.)

The minutes of the June 9th meeting were read. Motion by Mr. Chaka; second by Mr. Gambrell to adopt. Vote unanimous.

The minutes of the June 22 Special Meeting were read. Motion by Mr. Chaka to approve; second Mr. Rampey. Vote unanimous.

Mr. Pickens Anderson and Mr. Hawkins of Piedmont Engineers made a presentation to Council.

#### Administrative Report

Ellers presented a report on Administrative Activities during the last quarter.

He then asked permission of Council to send two letters to the Pickens County Health Department. Both were approved. Ellers then presented a development program for the Town; the policy was accepted as information.

A letter from Mills Centre was presented which stated the availability of a Water Tank. No interest was expressed in pursuing that option.

Ellers presented a letter from Robert Newton concerning the development of Hamilton Place. No official action taken. Ellers requested permission to pay Mr. Cecil Bice \$100.00 for some damaged pine trees and permission to have Town employees cut down the trees. Approved.

#### New Business

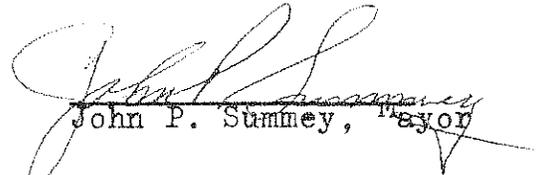
A letter presented by Mr. Leland Martin to be annexed into the Town. Motion by Mr. Gambrell; second by Chaka to approve- vote unanimous.

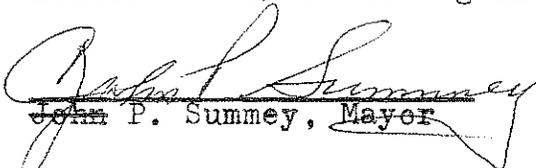
