August 2, 1962

The Town Council met Thursday Night, August 2, 1962, with all members present.

Mayor Carson presided. The minutes of the last meeting were read. Mr. Canup made a motion that the minutes be adopted. Mr. Wilson seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

The proposed route for highway S-18 was discussed also the resurfacing of the rest of the road near Pratt Read Co.. Mr. Busha said that he would talk with Duke Power Officials and find out what they intended to do about the road which is on or near their property.

A road running from Mt. Zion Cemetery to the Old Shirley Road was discussed. Mr. Cranford made a motion that Mr. Cumbie, Surveyor, study the possibility of this proposed road. Mr. Canup seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mr. Carson mentioned the resurfacing of Gassaway St. and Maw Bridge Road to the city limits with black topping and said that he would get an estimate from Daniel Construction Co. ~~of about~~ the cost.

Managers for the voting boxes were appointed. Mrs. Pearl Cranford, Mr. W.A. Perry & Mr. T. Voyles were appointed for the Cannon Mill Box which will be at the Mill Office. Miss Jessie Morgan, Mr. Felix Young & Mr. Lester Pinson were appointed for the Town box which will be at the Central Park. The City Clerk was appointed Supervisor of the Election. Mr. Wilson made a motion that the appointment of the above named people be accepted. Mr. Cranford seconded the motion. The Council agreed. The Council also agreed to have the County Registration Board to come to the City Hall thirty days prior to the election.

A discussion was held on raising the fee on cemetery lots. Mr. Busha made a motion that lots on the back side of the cemetery which were \$10.00 be raised to \$20.00 per space and the front lots near the road be raised from \$20.00 each to \$30.00 per space. Mr. Cranford seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

The Council discussed renting or buying new Christmas decoration for the Town. Mr. Cranford made a motion that Mr. Carol Carpenter of Hickory, N.C., meet with the Mayor and Town Council next meeting night and give some prices on Christmas decoration. Mr. Busha seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mr. Cranford made a motion that a questionnaire from the Housing & Home Finance Agency be answered and renew our certificate. Mr. Bryan seconded the motion.
