A regular meeting of the Town Council was held on Monday, August 4, 1969 at 7:00 P. M. with the following attending: Mayor, L. S. Griffin, Councilmen George Fowler, J. R. Herd, C. B. Bryan, A. R. Cureton, W. W. Norwood, and Herbert Thompson, Jr. Also present for the meeting were Mr. James Polk, Engineer with the Harwood Beebe Company and Mrs. Maude Chapman representing the Messenger.

Mayor Griffin presided over the meeting. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved and also the minutes of three special call meetings.

It was brought before the Council that Mr. J. A. Head had made a bid of \$1,000.00 for the ~~property~~ ^{18 miles (on creek)} property and that if the Town would accept this bid, that the Town would still have the pumping rights from now on out on this property. After some discussion on this matter, Councilman Herd made a motion, seconded by Councilman Norwood that no bids be accepted on this property. All Council agreed.

There was some discussion on the part-time policeman and his salary. It was decided to pay Mr. Furman Norris an additional \$45.00 on his salary for one weeks work that was in question, Councilman Norwood making this motion, with Councilman Bryan seconding. There was also some question as whether to employ Mr. Norris here as part-time policeman ^{while} also working for the Town of Liberty full time. Councilman Cureton made a motion, seconded by Councilman Fowler that we terminate the employment of Mr. Furman Norris, and be on the look-out for another part-time policeman.

Mr. James Polk, Engineer with the Harwood Beebe Company, was present and presented to the Council, in a discussion form, the revised Preliminary Report of June, 1965, on the Sanitary Sewerage System Improvements Program. After a lengthy discussion Councilman Bryan made a motion, seconded by Councilman Thompson, that we accept the recommendations on the Sanitary Sewerage System Improvement Program as recommended by Mr. James Polk, representative of the Harwood Beebe Company, and that they be authorized to proceed with the necessary steps by making application for federal grants and etc. This vote was unanimously carried by the Council.

No further business was transacted at this meeting.
