The Town Council met Monday Night, August 7, 1961, with the following attending: Mayor S.C. Carson, Councilmen, C.E. Bryan, J.J. Canup, R.A. Busha, W.J. Wilson, H.M. Brooks, J.A. Cranford and Mrs. Maude Chapman representing the Messenger Paper.

Mayor Carson presided. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. Mr. Canup made a motion that the minutes be adopted. Mr. Busha seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

A discussion was held on securing a doctor for the Town. Mr. Brooks made a motion that a letter be written to the Medical Association in Charleston to find out what could be done in securing a doctor for the Town. Mr. Wilson seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mr. Busha made a motion that the town pay for the water to fill up the water line from the Wesleyan College to the Brock property.

The Council discussed ~~putting~~ running the sewage line to J.D. Walker's lot and W.H. Thompson's Jr,. Mr. Carson said that he would contact Stephen's Brothers and have them to go ahead with laying the line.

The new garbage pick-up plan was discussed, and thought to be adequate for the time being.
