Those present: Fowler, Hopkins, Kennemore, Thompson, Porter, Mayor Holladay, St. Supervisor John Head, Chief of Police, Harold Duncan.

Mayor called the meeting to order ask St. Supervisor, John Head, if he had anything to present to the Council.

John stated that the county did a great job patching through the town this week.

Council request limbs on Gaines St. be cut from over walk.

Request for a St. Light on Brock St. below Doug Boggs Council left this matter to the St. Committee to check if needed.

Mayor brought before the Council the opening of the new Carolina National Bank. Council felt we should place flowers or plant for the open house.

Chief Duncan stated that LEAP Fund granted approx. \$1500 for Police Communication through federal funding.

Ralph Alexander son-in-law(Sharack) called Mayor Holladay ask for a pool hall in the building on Main St. formerly known as Ray's Recreation. After discussion Council suggest that we ask him not to open a pool hall but suggest some other type of business.

A letter was read to the council pertaining to the current situation at a residential area where a business was on going. According to Acker & Acker after further study of the Zoning Ordinance he felt that if she ^{A Mae's Beauty Shop} met the qualification of floor space she would be in the clear according to the Town Zoning Ordinance. After much discussion Fowler made a motion to stay to the original decision of Feb. 11, 1975 in which a letter was written to Mae McAlister giving her 60 days to relocate. The motion was 2nd by Hopkins, those in favor were Hopkin, Porter, Kennemore & Fowler, opposed Mayor Holladay & Herbert Thompson Jr.

Fowler suggest that we comply with all others that were in violation of the Zoning Ordinance.

Mayor ask the present administration who & what concerning expansion for source of revenue purpose of the Town as Revenue Sharing was only granted through 1976 in which the Town would be hurting for revenue.


