

August 13, 1984

Regular Council Meeting

Present: Mayor Summey, Councilmen Carl Rampey, Dan Evatt, "Doc" Evatt, Troy Porter, Frank Chaka, Henry Law; Paul Davidson, Greenville News; Sue Seaborn, Monitor; Ronnie Barnett, Messenger; Al Cumbie, Bobby Busha.

Mayor Summey called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.

Minutes of the July 9, 1984 meeting was read. Motion by Carl Rampey, second by Henry Law to approve. Vote unanimous.

Council Reports:

Henry Law--Financial report

Frank Chaka--Since water and sewer fund is solvent, need to be replacing some of the galvanized pipe on Gaines Street. Put impact fees discussion for next work session.

Troy Porter--Gassaway Street residents need to be taped onto 6" line for better pressure.

Carl Rampey--No report

Dan Evatt---Some patching had been done in Pine Knoll, more needed. Grant money discussed for looping line from 1st Bapt Church to John Wade's house for fire hydrants at school.

"Doc" Evatt----None

Administrator's Report:

Upgrading building permits, renovation permits, and business license. Letter to be sent to cemetery users for contributions.

Motion by Dan Evatt second by Frank Chaka to construct ordinance for upgrade of fees with the exception of cemetery fees. This to be discussed in next work session Sept. 4
Prices on lawn mowers and weed eaters discussed. Motion by Dan Evatt second by "Doc" Evatt to purchase a weed eater and lawn mower in the the \$500 or \$550 range. Vote unam.

OLD BUSINESS:

SECOND READING ON GO BOND ORDINANCE Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Henry Law to accept. Vote unanimous.

NEW BUSINESS:

Central Youth Baseball Association discussed. Motion by Henry Law, second by Troy Porter to follow by laws on file. Vote 5 yes 1 no (Dan Evatt dissented) "Doc" Evatt voted yes but understood Al, Bobby and Olin met and signed agreement, but doesn't look that way now (Dan Evatt voted no---Good opportunity to have Booster Club for support of program and council did not accept.)*

Bank account of approximately \$600 to be turned in to Recreation Department.

Motion by Troy Porter second by Dan Evatt to accept. Vote unanimous. (When turned in the difference between expenses and assets be designated for the tee-ball program to begin next season, at least \$300. balance to be used for overall recreation program.

ROBERT WOOD QUADS--- To get letter from his engineer and our engineer and see if 6" sewer tap is needed to replace the 4" tap there.

DAN PHILLIPS REQUEST---Administrator to get release from attorney Lindsay for \$350 settlement.

HWY 88 WATER DISTRICT--Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Dan Evatt to purchase another cut off valve and put 2 more on the line.

Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Dan Evatt to go into executive session.

Duties of administrator discussed, copy to be put in policy manual.

Hire new employee at \$4.50 hr.

Motion by Dan Evatt, second by Doc Evatt to adjourn executive.

Mayor recalled regular session and announced to press the actions of executive session.
