August 25, 1969

A regular meeting of the Town Council was held on Monday, August 25, 1969 at 7:00 P. M. with the following attending: Mayor, L. S. Griffin, Councilmen Herbert Thompson, Jr., W. W. Norwood, J. R. Herd, George Fowler, A. R. Cureton, and C. B. Bryan. Also present for the meeting was Mrs. Maude Chapman, representing the Messenger.

This meeting was held in lieu of the regular September 1, 1969 Council Meeting.

Mayor L. S. Griffin presided over the meeting. The minutes were read and approved.

A request from R. F. & Beatrice Dobson to come into the city limits of the Town of Central consisting of three lots and being approximately 3.3 acres, joining the Mill property and fronting the public road (Church Street Extension), was brought before the Council. Councilman Thompson made a motion, seconded by Councilman Bryan, to grant this request.

The problem of beer drinking and old junked cars was discussed further. Mayor Griffin reported that these matters had been turned over into the hand's of Mr. John Gentry for the drawing up of some type of Ordinance against this in the Town of Central.

There was some question of employing another part-time police, but nondefinite action was taken.

There was some discussion on John Head's Garbage Contract, and it was suggested that he be given an increase in salary. After discussion, Councilman Herd made a motion, seconded by Councilman Cureton, that John's ~~salary~~ be increased from \$130.00 to \$140.00 per week. Also, Councilman Thompson made a motion, seconded by Councilman Cureton that the Clerk's salary be raised from \$70.00 to \$80.00 per week. Both motions were unanimously carried.

There was discussion on purchasing a new or a used police car, but no action was taken.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned.
