

# Town of Central

September 3, 1964

The Town Council met Thursday night, September 3, 1964, with the following attending: Mayor J.A. Cranford, Councilmen C.B. Bryan, J.L. Martin, W.J. Wilson, R.A. Busha. Mrs. Maude Chapman representing the Messenger Paper and Bob Bradley representing the Greenville News were also present.

Annexation of property owned by Miss Amanda Patterson, A.R. Cureton and Earle Crane, was discussed further. Mr. Wilson made a motion that this property be taken into the Town limits providing that no services other than garbage pickup and police protection be extended to this area until further planning by the Council. Mr. Busha seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mr. Cranford read a letter from Mr. Alton Cumbie asking the Town to give a donation to the Central Booster Club. The council decided to wait until next meeting night to make a decision on this.

Mr. Martin was appointed by the mayor to check on equipment which will be needed to equip another Fire Truck which the Volunteer firemen plan to purchase, also check on size of reel needed for the Fire Truck now owned by the Town.

Mr. Wilson made a motion that the Town give \$15.00 to the State Magazine as a memorial to Mr. Jefferies. Mr. Bryan seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

A discussion was held on putting Town Ordinances into book form and future plans for a New Town Hall or the possibility of moving to the old Elementary School building. But no action taken.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned.
