A regular meeting of the Town Council was held on Tuesday, September 3, 1968, at 7:00 P. M. with the following attending: Mayor L. S. GRIFFIN, Councilmen C. B. Bryan, W. W. Norwood, G. H. Werner, J. R. Herd, W. A. Parsons, and A. R. Cureton. Also present for the meeting were Kenneth Willmott, Jr., with the Easley Progress, and Mrs. Maude Chapman with the Messenger.

Mayor L. S. Griffin presided over the meeting. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved, and also the minutes of two (2) call meetings were read and approved.

Councilman Bryan made a motion seconded by Councilman Herd that the Town of Central pay \$88.38 for the 1968-69 Membership Fees to the Municipal Association of South Carolina. All the Council agreed.

Mayor Griffin reported that the new fire truck was in Greenville, and that it would be delivered to the Town of Central on Sept. 6, 1968.

The question pertaining to the proposal made by members of the Fire Department was presented to the Council, regarding the building of a new Fire Station, with the members of the Fire Department furnishing the labor and the Town of Central furnishing the Materials. After some discussion, Councilman Bryan made a motion that this question be tabled to a later date. All the Council agreed.
