The Town Council met Thursday night, Sept. 5, 1963, with the following attending: Mayor J.A. Cranford, Councilmen C.B. Bryan, W.J. Wilson, J.L. Martin, A.R. Curton, R.A. Bushe. Mrs. Maude Chapman representing the Messenger Paper was present also Rev. Willis.


Mayor Cranford presided. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved, after which Rev. Willis gave his reason for being present. He stated that he was representing the Church of God of Prophecy asking permission to connect on the Town water. The Council agreed to let the church connect to the water at their own expense. He also stated that they would like to connect to the sewage if possible. No decision was made on the sewage until further checking the fell.

The sewage problem near Mr. Brooks house was also discussed. But no decision this.


Mr. Wilson stated that the water pressure on Gaines Street was low and would like for Mr. Golden to check on this.

Mr. Cranford said the Hasley-Central water District had not made a decision on leasing the Central Filterplant. It was decided to keep the plant running two hours each day until checking further as to what the decision would be on the plant.

Purchasing a lot near the Southern Bell Telephone Co. was discussed. Mr. Martin made a motion that the Town purchase the lot from Mr. H.G. Dowling at the price of \$1500.00. Mr. Bushe seconded the motion. The Council agreed.
