A regular meeting of the Town Council was held on Tuesday night, September 5, 1967, at 7:00 P.M., with the following attending: Mayor, L.S. Griffin, Councilmen C.B. Bryan, A.R. Cureton, W.W. Norwood, G.H. Werner, W.A. Parsons, and J.R. Herd. Mrs. Maude Chapman, representing the Messenger Paper was also present.

Mayor Griffin presided over the meeting. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

The Committee for Housing Town Equipment reported and recommended that a wire fence be erected at the Town Property on Gaines Street, and for the Mayor to secure ~~XXXXXXX~~ bids, and also have Mr. A.B. Cumbie to survey the property to determine the exact corners, and property lines before the fence was built.

Councilman W.W. Norwood made a motion, <sup>seconded by Councilman C.B. Bryan</sup> to purchase a scrape blade for the town tractor to be used in cleaning roadways and sidewalks. The cost of this blade will cost approximately \$325.00.

Town Council authorized John Head to purchase the needed materials to flush the town sewers, as this is an annual practice.

A request from Wess Dobson regarding the sewerage from his basement was discussed. No definite decision was made on this matter.

Councilman Bryan made a motion, seconded by Councilman Werner, to purchase a sectional-rod-cleaning device for the sewerage lines. All council members agreed.

Painting of the town garbage truck at a cost of around \$250.00 was voted on, with McLee's Garage, Inc. in Anderson to do the work.

A request by Mr. S.C. Carson regarding buying sand from the old filter plant site on 18 Mile Creek Road was discussed. After some discussion, Councilman Bryan ~~made~~ made a motion that this be further considered, with Mr. Carson's possibilities of some agreement of about \$50.00 for the first year and about \$100.00 there after. All council members agreed.

The Town Council agreed to employ Mr. A.M. Sheriff as policeman for one day per week, to work on the day that Chief A.C. Arnold takes his day off.

A discussion was held on a concealed weapon taken from Riley F. Lackey. Chief Arnold had been contacted that some member of the family wanted to purchase this weapon. Councilman Bryan made a motion ~~seconded~~ seconded by Councilman Parsons that the weapon be sold to this member for \$10.00. All Council members agreed.

A petition by residents on 18 Mile Creek Road was presented to the Council requesting ~~for~~ a water line be laid, but the discussion was deferred to a later meeting.

Council voted to pay \$88.38 for the 1967-68 membership in the South Carolina Municipal Association.
