Minutes of September 6, 1960

The Town Council of Central, S.C. held their regular meeting September 6, 1960 in the Town Hall with the following attending: Mayor S.C. Carson and Councilmen, F.E. Young, D.R. Duncan, Cleo Bolding, C.B. Bryan, and Arthur Dyar, Chief of Police Tom Reams, Visitors Mrs. Maude Chapman - representing the Messenger paper and Mr. Norman Friedman - representing the Leader paper.

The minutes of the last meeting was read and approved.

Mr. Cleo Bolding reported that Mr. Ed Kelly was having trouble with his water being muddy and wanted the council to have it cleared up. There was discussion about others having the same trouble on several dead-ends. No action was taken on this.

Discussion was held on raising the price of Tap- ons to the sewer because the council sees the need to raise the price so as to able to keep up the disposal plants and for needy repairs and improvements to keep up the system. No action was taken on this.

Discussion was held on better garbage collection. No action was taken on this. Mr. Carson told the council that no plans had been made to pay Mr. Eliff McAlister for taking care of Mr. Bill Gaines' s job while he was away for several weeks as that was between Mr. Gaines and Mr. McAlister.

Mr. Bolding made a motion to Change the price of \$5.00 to \$10.00 Opening fee to Mt. Zion Cementery. Mr. Bryan second the motion. The council agreed.
