*Sept. 7, 1962*

The Town Council met Thursday night, September 7, 1962, with the following attending: Mayor S.C. Carson, Councilmen C.B. Bryan, H.M. Brooks, R.A. Busha, J.J. Canup, W.J. Wilson, J.A. Cranford. Mrs. Maude Chapman, a representative of the Messenger Paper was also present.

Mayor Carson presided over the meeting. The minutes were read and approved.

A discussion was held on renting or buying new Christmas decoration for the Town. Mr. Cranford gave some rental prices which were given by a representative of Carrol A. Carpenter Co., Hickory, N.C.. Mr. Brooks made a motion that a contract for three (3) years be signed for renting the equipment as Mr. Cranford had given prices for, which would cost \$906.00 the first year, \$684.00 the second year and \$379.00 the third year. Mr. Bryan seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mr. Canup said that several people who live out side of the town limits had ask about getting garbage pickup service from the town and paying a fee. Mr. Busha made a motion that this service not be given. Mr. Cranford 2nd the motion. The Council agreed.

A discussion was held on the Mayor and Councilmen's salary. Mr. Carson said that he thought the Mayor's salary should be raised from \$240.00 per year to \$500.00 per year and the Councilmen from \$3.00 per month to \$6.00 per month. Mr. Brooks made a motion that the Mayor's salary be \$500.00 per year and the Council salary be \$6.00 per month. Mr. Busha seconded the mothin. The Council agreed.

Mr. Carson announced that a meeting of the County Board, Mayor's of surrounding towns and Council members would hold a meeting at the Clemson House on Sept. 12th at 5:P.M. on the proposed Hartwell Dam Park Area.

Being no futher business the meeting adjourned.
