

REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
SEPT. 8, 1980  
MINUTES

Those present were councilmen Porter, Thompson, Boyles, Chaka & Evatt. Councilman Hopkins was absent. Mayor Holladay, Clerk Treas. Hughes, Admin. Jones, Chief of Police Fran Cantrell. Candidates for the Sept. 9, 1980 election: Carl Rampey, James G. Evatt, Jr., Olin Gambrell III, James R. Longo, John E. Summey & Clarence Phillips. Dr. George Rupp, Lee Gambrell, representatives from the Messenger & Pickens Sentinel & other citizens of the Town.

Mayor Holladay called the meeting to order and minutes were read and approved as read from the last council meeting.

Police report for the month of Aug. was presented to council by Chief Cantrell.

Administrator Jones presented the financial report for the month of Aug. 1980 to council and notation was made that in Intergovernmental Revenue we were a little short as anticipated. Copy in office file.

Administrator Jones presented to council a chart of Tax Revenue & Water & Sewer Revenue. Charts are in office of the administrator.

Administrator Jones briefed council that Mr. James Hampton had been contacted of council's action concerning the water & sewer lines being installed on the outside of the city limits and that Mr. Hampton was not interested in coming inside the city limits nor running the line himself at this time.


Administrator Jones briefed the council the cost of the light pole & lights was approx. \$1,100. This pole is located behind the U. S. Post Office on the recreation grounds & was in the process of being done.

Mr. Jones briefed council that the hearing had been received concerning the Census Report and that the Town had a gain of only (2) in housing and a less in vacant (79) from the first report.

Administrator Jones gave notation to council that Mr. Grady Ireland with Fort Hill Calbe T.V. had been contacted and Ireland said " the town in the areas where cable had not been run would be run as soon as he could hire some other contractors. His previous contractors contract expired Aug. 31, 1980.

Administrator Jones noted council on the Government Water Project Grant that the grant had been cut to \$143,000. Mr Jones stated that the town engineers were checking into this matter as this grant had already been cut once before.
