

REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
September 10, 1984

Mayor Summey called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.
Minutes of the Augut 7, 1984 meeting were read. Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Carl Rampey to accept. Vote unam.

Minutes of the August 13, 1984 meeting were read. Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Henry Law to accept. Vote unam.

Council Reports:

Henry Law--financial report

Frank Chaka--Cut-off valves discussed--Street numbering system needs to be finished.

Troy Porter--None

Carl Rampey--Police report

Dan Evatt--Noted that manholes on College St. and Johnson Road had been raised, waiting for asphalt to finish road.

"Doc" Evatt--Noted that football starts today. Need to follow up on upgrading appearance of underpass--Parking lines in town need to be painted.

IMPACT FEE ORDINANCE: Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Henry Law to accept on first reading. Vote unam.

SECOND READING--BUILDING PERMIT ORDINANCE--Discussion to print future business licenses so that last copy will be of durable cardboard, to be attached to the outside of structure in view of inspector. Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Dan Evatt to adopt. Vote unam.

BUSINESS LICENSE ORDINANCE--SECOND READING--Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Henry Law to accept. Vote unam.

Mayor's Report:

Discussed prisoners picking cans, etc. from garbage. Henry Law suggested that if prisoners could not follow rules which were given them (this being not to take items from garbage) send them back to stockade. No exceptions.

Ms. Nita Canoy presented request for sewer service at the Chandler house on Wesleyan Drive, request granted for tap fee of \$950. Future service and possible annexation discussed. No action.

Administrator's Report:

Duties of administrator. Motion by Dan Evatt, second by Henry Law to accept and put in policy manual with change in paragraph as recommended by Troy Porter to read that in case of emergency, in the absence of the administrator, council or mayor may give town employee a direct order.

Mr. Gambrell reported that to redo Gaines Street water line, 6" line with appurtenances would cost approx. \$9,000; 4" \$6,500; 2"---4,000; (This would be material only town crew to do work: To go up left side of street to avoid cutting the street.

Troy Porter asked that all houses on Gassaway St. be tapped on to 6" line as soon as possible and kill the existing line. Also tie in Ramseur Street.

CEMETERY LOTS--Motion by Troy Porter, second by Frank Chaka to raise inside per lot to \$200.00, for outside \$300.00, Vote unam.

Motion by Dan Evatt, second by Frank Chaka to amend the motion to include setting aside in escrow \$100 from each outside sale. Vote unam.

REQUEST FOR 5-ton tanker from surplus---Motion by Henry Law, second by Dan Evatt to give Mayor authority to sign request--Vote unam.

NAME BALL FIELD--Motion by Henry Law, second by Frank Chaka to honor request of Cannon Mills Co. and name the property CANNON MILLS PARK, and the ball field specifically be named ERNEST L. BOLICK BALLFIELD. (copy attached) Vote unam.

ANIMAL CONTROL HOURS AND PAY Motion by Frank Chaka, second by "Doc" Evatt to raise the hours to a maximum of 18 per week, at \$4.00 per hour beginning October 1, 1984. To give note as people put up water deposit concerning leash law. Vote unam.

ONE DAY A WEEK TRASH PICK UP_Motion by Troy Porter, second by Dan Evatt to table.
Vote unam.

Send letter of thanks to Roy Collins for bridge repair.


Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Troy Porter to go into executive session.
