REGULAR MEETING (COUNCIL)  
SEPT. 13, 1976

Those Present: Mayor Holladay, Councilmen Kennemore, Porter Busha, Fowler, Thompson, Chief of Police Harold Duncan, Clerk Catherine Hughes. Also meeting with the council was George Reid, Jimmy Langston & Mr. Reeves.

Mayor called the meeting to order.

Bethea stated to the council that according to Home Rule the Budget Ordinance must be passed before the year 1976-77 began. Motion by Thompson 2nd by Hopkins to adopt the Budget with revenue sharing for 1976-77 fiscal year. This was the first reading. Council approved.

Motion by Fowler seconded by Hopkins to adopt the Beer & Wine Ordinance that prohibited business from opening on Sundays but business must adhere to the code of laws of selling alcoholic beverages on Sundays. This was the final reading on this ordinance. Council Approved.

Motion by Porter 2nd by Thompson for the final reading on adoption of the Parking Violation Ordinance. Council approved.

Mayor gave the floor to Mr. Jimmy Langston who requested annexation of Spring Forest which is located behind the housing project on Watkins St. and graded with approximately 20 lots for trailers. After much discussion was made Langston made a two fold request of annexation of all property except the shopping center area. Langston stated that building would start immediately on apts & homes. Mayor asked the question of streets, paving & etc. Langston said that he had been assured that when street were level that the county would make roads passable. The purpose of this annexation was for water & sewer lines to be laid as soon as possible. Mayor suggested that the council study this further and work with John Head and be brought up at a called meeting.

George Reid came before the council requested water to his property down the Maw Bridge Rd. Reid stated that there were approximately 12 person wanting water to their homes. This matter was to be discussed at a later date. No action taken.

Motion by Fowler 2nd by Hopkins to purchase water & sewer pipe from Davis Meter Co. 6500 ft. of 6" sewer pipe, 2600 ft. of 2" water 800 ft. of 6" sewer 12 tees & (6 fire hydrants approximately \$308.00 each.) Council approved.

Fowler made a suggestion that Langston come into the city with property down the Madden Bridge Rd. No action taken.
