Regular Council Meeting

Mr. Bice discussed a problem that he had with the construction
in front of his house. Council agreed with his sentiments;
Mr. Evatt stated that the important thing was to decide what
to do.

The following resolution was drafted for the Highway Department:

Be it resolved that the Central Town Council requests that
construction be stopped in front of the property owned by
Mr. Paul Porter and Mr. Cecil O. Bice on Brock Street; pending
resolution of the difficulties regarding the location of the
center line.

Motion by Gambrell to adopt; second by Mr. Chaka.
Vote unanimous.

Council Report

Mr. Chaka made the request that old water lines be replaced a
little at a time.

Mr. Gambrell presented the financial report.

Mr. Rampey presented the police report. He also requested that
the leash law be enforced in a more strict manner.

Chief Cantrell's request for permission for Criminal Justice
students to ride in patrol cars was tabled pending further
investigation.

Mr. Evatt-He stated that the Recreation department needed to obtain
a designation as a non-profit organization in order to receive
any further United Fund monies. Mrs. Towe stated that she was
already proceeding on that project.

Mr. Evatt further stated that the Football Program was under way
and that he would appreciate crowd support for the young people.
The Mayor informed the Council of the pending visit of Mr. Morris
and Mr. Brooks. He also thanked the Council for sending him
to the Municipal Association Convention.
