

Regular Council Meeting
September 15, 1987
7:00 P. M.

Mayor Cumbie called the meeting to order.

Invocation by Mr. Holladay.

Minutes of the August 10, 1987 meeting were read. Motion by Mr. Law, second by Mr. Chaka to accept as read. Vote unanimous.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mr. LaW _ Gave Police report. No report for fire department.

Mr. Chaka - Gave financial report. Within budget budget for month.

Mr. Porter- Mr. Gambrell updated council on status of recreation department.

Mr. Phillips- Updated council on status of American House Spinning unaccounted for water.

No report on sewer

Mr. Holladay - Troy Grant property discussed as to rezoning. Mayor Cumbie made a motion to present this request to the Planning Commission, second by Mr. Law. vote unanimous.

Mr. Evatt - Streets and Sanitation--Letter from Cannon Memorial Baptist Church (copy Attached) was discussed, this concerning closing of Folger Street and re-routing, after discussion motion by Mayor Cumbie, second by Mr. Chaka to refer to Planning Commission. For this motion was Mr. Phillips, Mr. Holladay, Mr. Evatt, Mr. Chaka, Mayor Cumbie (Mr. Law abstained because of conflict of interest).

Noted that old car and junk at Helping Hands must be moved. Green box for Helping Hands and Central Hardware to be obtained.

Mr. Gambrell to bid out towns old cars again. Noted that an old car on Gaines Street across from old jail has been setting for a length of time and needs to be removed.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. John Norris and John Head of the Fire Department were recognized for discussion of items in the budget. ~~Noted that two new air packs were needed now and 2 a year until ample supplies were obtained.~~ Mayor Cumbie request that a list of needs be presented now so that these needs could be bought from the current years budget reserve. Inspection situation was discussed. Fire department to draft a letter of intent to be given all merchants before actual inspections begin. This way they will know what to expect.

Mr. Garrick discussed the water and sewer budget and had no complaints.

Motion by Mr. Chaka, second by Mr. Law to adopt budget as is on first reading. Vote unanimous.

Recreation budget discussed. Motion by Mr. Holladay, second by Mr. Chaka to adopt. Vote unanimous.
