Sept. 18, 1978

Council gave authority to the town administrator to give a letter of consideration of water to residents in the area of George Reids, Nord Lac Sub Division if area wants to come inside the city limits.

Council gave the Town Administrator approval for St. lights in the Pine Knoll Development and other needed areas.

Quote from Data Control Computer Service of \$150.00 per month was in consideration. Council wants to study this information further.

Motion by Thompson 2nd by Hopkins to reappoint Mr. L.O. Evatt, Mr. F.E. Kirkley whose term is to expire 30 Sept. 1979 that Mr. E.L. Bolick and Mr. Hal Garrett whose term will expire 30 Sept. 1980, and a replacement of Mr. S.C. Carson by request to Mr. L.S. Griffin whose term will expire 30 Sept. 1980 to the Central Planning Commission. Council feels that this time of expiration will give new council a chance of appointing or reappointing the commission on Oct. 1st meeting of the Town's fiscal year.

Special All meeting for swearing in new council members schedule for Sept. 29, 1978 if a run off election is not necessary.

The meeting of Council scheduled for Sept. 25, 1978 for 7 p.m. has been scheduled for 6:30 in order for council to attend the 1st meeting of the Pickens Municipal Association.

Meeting with council was roommate of Thomas Holmes who claims he was treated unfair on a disconnection of a water bill of Aug. 1, 1978 and also stated that the 1st bill of \$4.50 had not been taken off the billing of 8/1/78. After much discussion Thompson stated to roommate of Thomas Holmes he would check computer print out and make a decision and get in touch with him.

Motion by Thompson 2nd by Hopkins to grant authority to Melvin Brooks with the Shriners for a Hillbilly Day in the Town of Central. Council approved.

Motion by Hopkins second by Thompson to adopt the 1st reading of the Budget Ordinance for 1978-79 in the amount of \$391,587. Council approved.

New Business:

Letter was received from the Central Planning Commission of a recommendation to rezone lots 14 & 15 in Spring Forest Sub Division from R-12 to G.R. in order to build apts on these lots. Council did not take any action on this matter other than to advertise this change in the paper for two weeks and hold a hearing.

REPORT OF THE TOWN ADMINSTRATOR

Legal council has reported that he is proceeding with the several annexations, which has been referred to him for action. He is waiting on a ruling from the Attorney General's office at this time.

He has request more information on the Mann case.

We have written letters on sewer connection. Follow up will continue on each of these. One is requiring an extension of our present line and a manhole. The line and installation of the manhole should be completed today.

Our Engineer was requested to furnish more information on the water line on the White Oak Circle Project. He feels that we should have the permit this week. Solicit- of bids will be started this week.

Mr Danny Reeves, came by today and resigned his position.

We have hired Mr. Thomas to check the Waste Water Trea- ment plants on the week-ends. The rate of pay was \$5.00 per hour or the total of \$20.00 per week

The Petroleum Company has installed a new pump for our gasoline. This should end our problems in this area.

The problem of space here in Town Hall is being studied. We are now looking in the area of renovating the old Town Hall for the Police Department. We will be pre- senting more definite to Council when we finish our cost studies.

The Town must have an Affirmative Action plan by the 30th of September. A Seminar will be held by COG on this on the 21st. We will be attending and hope of have a plan to present to Council next week.

Each of the Departments have been asked to give a report to Council on it/s regular monthly meeting night. Theese are included in your packet. Items listed are other than routine.
