Mayor Holliday presided over the meeting. He stated that he received a letter from Harris Page Smith concerning the resurfacing of Brock Street and that he had talked with Jim Polk about "Operator Manual" which will be 80% funded and 20% by the Town, also that a grant of \$6,800.00, had been approved for the park.

A discussion was held on the annexation of Central Wesleyan College. Councilman O'Dell made a motion that Councilman Cumbie talk with officals at the college and try to get a survey made. Councilman Thompson seconded the motion. This vote was unanimous.


An open discussion was held on the " Study of ~~the~~ County collecting municipal taxes which was brought up in the County Municipal Meeting.
