Mr. Cranford was sworn in by out going Mayor Carson, and the Councilmen sworn in by the City Clerk. Mr. Carson thanked the Councilmen and new Mayor for their co-operation while serving as Mayor of the Town.

Mr. Cranford appointed committees for the next two years as follows: W.J. Wilson & C.B. Bryan, Finance Committee. R.A. Busha & A.R. Cureton, Water Dept.. H.M. Brooks & J.L. Martin, Street Dept. .


Mr. Cranford read applications from City employees. Mr. Wilson made a motion that all present employees be retained. Mr. Busha seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

A discussion was held on resurfacing Werner St., and moving dirt near Mr. Werner's house which was left there by the County. No action was taken on resurfacing the street but it was decided that John Head would move the dirt from near his home.

A street light being needed on Ramseur St. was discussed. Mr. Busha made a motion that street light be put on Ramseur St.. Mr. Martin seconded the motion. Lights being needed on Woodson St. and Meredith were mentioned. Mr. Brooks was appointed to check these streets.

A Town Lawyer and Auditor was discussed, but no action taken.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned.
