October 4, 1965

The Town Council met Thursday night, October 4, 1965, with the following attending: Mayor W.C. Kelley, Councilmen G.D. O'Dell, W.J. Wilson, R.A. Busha, J.B. Martin, J.R. Herd, Jerry Lesley. Mrs. Waude Chapman, representing the Messenger Paper was also present.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved after which Mayor Kelley gave reports on the following: The State Hwy. Dept. had been contacted about painting yellow lines at the Under Pass. The School-Boy Patrol had been successfully organized. Mayor Kelley also stated that repairing the old town jail had advantages and disadvantages and ask the Town Council to give more thought about repairs until next meeting.

Councilman Lesley, stated that the Junior Chamber of Commerce was planning a Christmas Parade and would like for the Town to help with expenses. Councilman Herd made a motion that the Town contribute \$50.00 to help with expenses of the parade. Councilman O'Dell seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

A Discussion was held on the possibility of moving the Town Hall to the Old Central Elementary School Bldg., Martin made a motion that the Council get together and explore the possibility of building a new Town Hall & Fire Dept. on the lot on Church Street rather than cost of repairs on old school. Councilman Busha seconded the motion. The Council well agreed. Mayor Kelley appointed Martin & Busha to check on possibilities of the new building.

Retirement for the Policeman was discussed, but the Council decided go give this more thought and make a decision later.

A discussion was held on the need for a new truck or repair on the old truck for the water Dept. The Council decided to get prices on repairs and new trucks.

Mayor Kelley stated that the Garbage pick-up truck was being repaired in Columbia. Councilman Wilson suggested that the truck also needed painting.

Councilman Martin made a motion that the Policeman be given a \$10.00 raise in salary beginning on the 11day of November. Councilman Busha 2nd motion. The Council agreed.

A discussion was held upon Mr. Golden's resignation as water Works Supt.. The Council decided to ask Mr. Golden if he would take a \$10.00 raise in salary and stay with the Town.

The Council also agreed to give the Supt. of Streets and Town Clerk a \$10.00 raise per week in salary.

Being no futher business the meeting adjourned.
