A regular meeting of the Town Council was held on Monday, October 5, 1970 at 7:00 P. M. at the Town Hall with the following attending: Mayor L. S. Griffin, Mayor H. R. Holladay, Councilmen J. R. Herd, Herbert Thompson, Jr., George Fowler, A. B. Cumbie, Jr., Jack Kennemore and Glen D. O'Dell. Also present for the meeting was Mrs. Maude Chapman representing the Messenger, Mr. Bill Davey from the Easley Progress, and Mr. Jerry Alexander with the Anderson Independent.

Mayor H. R. Holladay was sworn into office to serve as Mayor for the next two years, and Councilmen Glen D. O'Dell, Jack Kennemore, and A. B. Cumbie, Jr. were sworn into office to serve as Councilmen for the next four years.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and Councilman Cumbie made a motion that the minutes be approved as read, Councilman Kennemore seconded this motion. Motion was un-animously carried.

A request from Mr. Robert Norris to be granted a beer license was brought before the Council. After discussion on this subject, Councilman Fowler made a motion to protest this said request on the grounds that the facilities are inadequate, also that there is now at present a beer joint right over this building, there could be the problem of congested traffic in front of business, and also being a basement room it would be very inconvenient for proper police protection. Councilman Cumbie seconded this motion and it was unanimously carried.

Discussion was held on a petition to empower the Town Council of Central, S. C. to hold a referendum on the issuance of \$335,000 bonds for improving the Sewer System. Councilman Thompson made a motion, seconded by Councilman Herd to proceed with plans for holding this referendum on the issuance of bonds, for November 10, 1970. This vote was unanimously carried.

There was some discussion on the Accountant for the fiscal year of 1969-1970. A motion was made by Councilman Fowler that we employ Marchant L. Lesley for the Accountant again this year, motion was seconded by Councilman O'Dell. This motion was unanimously carried.

There was some discussion on our Town Attorney. It had been suggested that we employ an Attorney who would have more time to spend with the Town affairs than our present Attorney, Mr. John Gentry. Councilman Kennemore made a motion that we contact Mr. W. G. Acker and ask for his services as our Town Attorney. Councilman Herd seconded this motion and it was unanimously carried.
