A regular meeting of the Town Council was held on Monday, October 7, 1968 at 7:00 P. M. with the following attending: Mayor L. S. Griffin, Councilmen George Fowler, Herbert Thompson, Jr., J. R. Herd, A. R. Cureton, C. B. Bryan, and W. W. Norwood. Also present for the meeting were Kenneth Willmott, Jr., with the Easley Progress, and Mr. Thomas H. Turner and Mr. Pickens Anderson, with Piedmont-Engineering Firm. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mayor L. S. Griffin was sworn into office to serve as Mayor for the next two (2) years, and Councilmen George Fowler, Herbert Thompson, Jr., and J. R. Herd were sworn into office to serve as Councilmen for the next four (4) years.

Mr. Thomas H. Turner and Mr. Pickens Anderson from the Piedmont Engineering Firm presented some recommendations regarding the Sewerage System and the needs to be considered adequate to take care of the present and for the future needs. Councilman Fowler made a motion seconded by Councilman Bryan, that a preliminary application be filed, by this Engineering Firm, for Federal assistance in which does not obligate this Town to the Piedmont-Engineering Firm, and if Federal grants were approved, we would then decide if we would use this firm further, or go into this matter with some other Engineering Firm.

There was some discussion on the maintenance of the water storage tank, and after the discussion, Councilman Bryan made a motion seconded by Councilman Thompson, that we have the Georgia Tower & Tank Maintenance of Lavonia, Georgia service said water storage tank for the sum described in the Proposed Contract. All Council agreed.
