

Regular Council Meeting
October 8, 1990
7:00 P. M.

Present: Mayor Alton B. Cumbie, III; Councilmen Clarence Phillips; Stan Thompson; "Doc" Evatt; Frank Chaka; Harry Holladay; Councilwoman Lou Robinson; Mr. Allen Baker, Kay Powers, Meals on Wheels, Herbert Thompson, Administrator; Grace S. Towe, Clerk.

Mayor Cumbie called the meeting to order.
Invocation by "Doc" Evatt.

Minutes of the September 10, 1990 meeting were read. After correction of Mayor's report to read "18 Mile Creek Committee" instead of Town, motion by Clarence Phillips, second by Frank Chaka to accept. Vote was unanimous.

Minutes of the Special called meeting of October 1, 1990 were read. Motion by Stan Thompson, second by Frank Chaka to accept as read. Vote unanimous.

Mayor Cumbie recognized Kay Powers of Meals on Wheels. Ms. Powers related the status of Meals on Wheels for the Central area. She noted that drivers were desperately needed and 3 short at the present time. Mayor Cumbie assured her that every effort would be made to obtain some volunteers.

OLD BUSINESS:

Stan Thompson - Need to get resolution ready for Officer Roger Teets by the time he completes his training at the Criminal Justice Academy.

Frank Chaka - Mr. Chaka reviewed the financial report for the year ending September 30, 1990. Overall report was good with surplus for year.

Lou Robinson -- No report.

Clarence Phillips - No report.

Harry Holladay - Noted that Local Option Sales Tax issue needs to be talked up before election time.

"Doc" Evatt - Reported that street work by county had been completed.

NEW BUSINESS:

Stan Thompson - Read Ordinance #90-10-9 concerning enforcement on complaint basis for burning inside town limits. Motion by Stan Thompson, second by Frank Chaka to adopt. Council polled: Yes: Stan Thompson, Frank Chaka, Lou Robinson, "Doc" Evatt, Harry Holladay, Clarence Phillips, Mayor Alton Cumbie. Vote unanimous. No no votes.

Frank Chaka- Noted that the cemetery was being cut.

Lou Robinson _ Reported that the Planning Commission had met on Tuesday. Maps were presented and a hearing set for October 30, 1990. Discussion of parking on sidewalks. Public hearing and place for meeting discussed.

Clarence Phillips - no report.

Harry Holladay - no report.

"Doc" Evatt - Reported that stop sign needs to be placed at exit of Taylor's Trailer Park. Duke Power Company in process of putting new light at the new road off Gaines Street. Discussion of culverts and aprons for drive ways in town. This to be done by work order only and fee to be paid before work order issued. This is policy and one reading only is needed. Motion by "Doc" Evatt, second by Harry Holladay to adopt. Vote unanimous.

Administrator's Report:

Fire proof filing cabinet discussed. Herbert Thompson reported that he could obtain one from Office Depot for \$649.00 plus tax. Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Stan Thompson to proceed with the purchase. Council was polled. Yes: Stan Thompson, Frank Chaka, Lou Robinson, "Doc" Evatt, Harry Holladay, Clarence Phillips, Mayor Alton Cumbie. Vote unanimous.

Mayor's report:


Reported that a news letter was ready for mailing. Noted that a truck had been placed at the back of the old school house, this to be for news papers only. Containers for different items to be obtained. King's Recycling will pick up when there is a full load. Six to eight push carts needed. Will try to get free ones but if have to pay \$35.00 to \$50.00 each.

Mayor Cumbie reappointed all persons who have the appointed status to leave as is and if specific problem arises, bring up at that point and deal with specifics. Consensus of council for each to stay in current position.

Work session needed for November 13, 1990. 18 mile discharge group with written policy on what Central can do.

"Doc" Evatt asked about status of annexing Duke Power, and American House of Spinning. Noted water line on Gaines Street waiting for Highway Department approval, no further business,
