MINUTES

REGULAR MEETING

Those Present: Fowler, Porter, Thompson, Hopkins, Kennemore, Busha, Mayor Holladay, Chief Duncan, St. Supervisor John Head, Jerry Alexander (Independent Daily News).

Mayor called the meeting to order stated that the final inspection for the sewerage system was inspected Oct. 8, 1974 with all major operation satisfactory. Results of the audit shown a \$13,000 not used by EPA Grant, additional equipment was being purchased if accepted by the council. Motion by Porter, 2nd by Busha to accept this purchase Council Approved.

Mayor stated that the revenue sharing check for the qtr. had been received in the amt. \$9,685.00.

Membership dues for the Municipal Association in the amt. of \$424.00 was in discussion, after consideration council felt to check into this matter further, before paying.

Mayor stated that citizens who hadn't tied onto the new sewerage system had approx. 18 months left according to the sewerage ordinance. Tap on fee \$200.00 plus 50% surcharge each month of the water bill (inside). Tap on fee ~~\$300.00~~ plus 100% surcharge each month of the water bill (outside).

Mayor stated the need of inventory of supplies, equipment, etc. for the next regular council meeting.

St. Dept.) Motion made by Fowler, 2nd by Hopkins to run 2000 ft. of pipe for Mr. Jim Chisman in the Nord-Lac Subdivision, Chisman furnish pipe Town furnish labor. Council approved.

John Head stated to the council that he had been in touch with Ray Collins who would be available to open ditches soon.

Fowler stated that there were (3) St. lights at the Cannon Mills that were of no value which the town was paying. Motion by Kennemore, 2nd by Porter to move lights, (1) at the new parking lot at the mill, 1) at the Bolick house, 1) at the W&S Monument on Main St., also gave authority to the St. Committee to place 2 or 3 more where needed. Council approved.

Fowler stated a tree on Gaines St. needed to be cut, John to take care of this matter. (Bees)

Motion made by Thompson, 2nd by Kennemore to proceed with bonded coverage for the policeman. Council approved, \$4,000 @ \$14 per year, Chief \$2,000 @ \$7 per year, Polic

Partime Roy Golden to 3.20 per hour. Porter and Kennemore opposed.

Motion carried, also effective Jan. 1, 1975 each employee will be reviewed in compliance with their anniversary date. At this time an employee's measure of human performance would be evaluated and his salary adjusted accordingly.
