MINUTES of COUNCIL MEETING

At the regular monthly meeting of The Town Council of The Town of Central, Central, South Carolina, held in the Town Office at seven o'clock Wednesday night, November 2, 1949 were: G. M. Perry, Mayor, W. A. Gaines, Chief of Police, Councilmen: F. W. Hopkins, Herman Sanders, R. A. Busha, T. A. Phillips and J. A. Mauldin.

General business matters were discussed which included the following:

A discussion of the Municipal Association meeting to be held in Greenwood, next Wednesday November 9, 1949 at Two o'clock. The Council instructed the Clerk to pay the annual dues of the Association which is \$44.88.

Mr. Perry reported that he had been able to borrow the \$10,000.00 which the Council authorized him to borrow at the last Council meeting, with interest at 5%.

The Surfacing treating that was done by E. O. Riddlehuber and Company was also discussed.

A resolution was passed: It was moved by T. A. Phillips and seconded by F. W. Hopkins and was unanimously voted by all: THAT- There will be no Hog Pens allowed within 500 yards of any residence within the incorporate limits of The Town of Central.

A Resolution: It was moved by R. A. Busha and seconded by T. A. Phillips and unanimously voted by all that: The deadline for each and every house and building to be hooked on to the Sewage System is, September 30, 1950, and all outdoor toilets will be done away with by this specific time, within the incorporate limits of The Town of Central.

This coming Sunday, November 6, 1949, contributions will be taken at the various Churches to help to Defray the cost of cleaning off Mt. Zion Cemetery.

It was moved by R. A. Busha and seconded by J. A. Mauldin that the Town would raise James Pool's salary from \$35.00 to \$40.00 weekly and would raise Luke's pay from 50¢ a hour to 60¢.

The meeting adjourned at 8:P. M.
