A regular meeting of the Town Council was held on Monday, November 2, 1970 at 7:00 P. M. at the Town Hall with the following attending:

Mayor H. R. Holladay, Councilmen Glen D. O'Dell, J. R. Herd, A. B. Cumbie, Jr., Herbert Thompson, Jr., George Fowler and Jack Kennemore. Also present for the meeting was Mrs. Maude Chapman representing the Messenger and Mr. J. W. Wallace.

The minutes of the last meeting and three special call meetings were read and approved.

Mr. J. W. Wallace made a request for sewerage and water for a proposed trailer court to be located on his property. There was a lengthy discussion on this request and it was decided to check into this situation further and give Mr. Wallace an answer within about one week.

Police Chief, Harold Duncan was present for the meeting and made a recommendation to the Council to employ William Harold McKern on the Police Force. Councilman Cumbie made a motion to employ McKern and there was a second to the motion by Councilman Kennemore. This vote was unanimous.

It was reported that the Sewer Treatment Course in which Mr. John Head is enrolled has extended approximately four weeks and the cost of this extended course would be around \$10.00 to \$15.00. Councilman Fowler made a motion seconded by Councilman Herd that the Town pay the necessary fees for this extended study for John. This vote was unanimous.

There was some discussion on the Christmas lights and decorations for the streets. Councilman O'Dell made a motion to spend as much as \$500.00 if needed for decorations this year. Councilman Fowler seconded this motion. This vote was unanimous.

Councilman Cumbie nominated Councilman Glen D. O'Dell to serve as Mayor Protem for term of 1970-1972, Councilman Kennemore seconded this nomination and it was unanimously carried.

A proposed budget for 1970-1971 was handed to each Councilman to study. Councilman Fowler made a motion to adopt said Budget as is as of November 1, 1970. Councilman Kennemore seconded the motion and it was unanimously carried.

It was recommended and discussed that the Town have a hospitalization insurance on the Town Employees with the Town paying  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the premium and the employee paying the other  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the premium. It was suggested that Councilman O'Dell and Councilman Thompson look into this matter and report back to the Council at a later date.

Councilman Glen D. O'Dell made a motion that each Town Employee be given a two week per year sick leave. If employee should be out over three days at a time, then he or she should bring a doctor's statement upon return to work. Councilman Thompson seconded this motion. This was unanimously adopted.

There was discussion on the extra labor that may be needed on the garbage collection, streets, and etc. It was decided that John Head be responsible for selecting his extra help and the Town pay this help per hour.

It was recommended that another auditor other than the one currently employed be asked to supervise all records and to make suggestions pertaining to the reporting of expenditures. It was suggested that Councilman O'Dell and Councilman Thompson proceed with the employment of another auditor.

There was a request from the Fire Department to purchase a set of mirrors for one of the fire trucks. Councilman O'Dell made a motion to purchase said mirrors, this motion was seconded by Councilman Cumbie. Motion was unanimously carried.

No further business was transacted at this meeting.
