November 3, 1966

The Town Council and Mayor held their regular meeting Thursday night, November 3, 1966, 7:00 P.M., with the following attending: Mayor L.S. Griffin, Councilmen C.B. Bryan, A.R. Cureton, W.W. Norwood, G.H. Werner, J.R. Herd, W.A. Parsons.

Mayor Griffin, presided over the meeting. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

A discussion was held on the Town Business License Ordinance. Councilman Bryan made a motion that the fees for Business License continue as in previous years. Councilman Cureton, seconded the motion. All Council members agreed.

Mayor Griffin, stated that he had received a letter from Mr. Robert Nash, of the Central Wesleyan College, stating that several ^{families} from the college community was interested in establishing a contract with the Town of Central for garbage pickup service. After much discussion, Councilman Cureton, made a motion that something be worked out between John Head and the College Community to use their truck when he is off duty with the Town, rather than the Town be involved since this is outside Town limits. Councilman Herd seconded the motion. All voted favorable.

A discussion was held on moving the Fire Station from J.R. Herd's property to the corner building on Main & Church Sts., owned by Messie & Jennie Morgan. Mayor Griffin, stated that he had talked with the property owners and the building could be rented for \$20.00 per month, and repairs on the building would cost approximately \$500.00 to \$600.00. Councilman Bryan, made a motion that a two (2) year contract be drawn up between the Town and property owners for lease of the property with an option of renewing said agreement at the end of the two year provided they ^{wish} wish to do so. Councilman Cureton, seconded the motion provided the Council continue plans for a new building in the future. All members agreed.

The Municipal Ladies Night Banquet, was discussed. Councilman Cureton, made a motion that all Town employees and guest be invited to the Banquet. Councilman Norwood, seconded the motion. All Council members agreed.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned.
