A list of people in violation of water and sewer taps was read. The council agreed that the town lawyer should be consulted as to the legality of going back several years to charge a tap fee. Council decided that each old case should be studied and those in violation since new ordinance went into effect will be contacted.


Councilman Cumbie made a motion that all town taxes be collected by the county. Councilman Fowler seconded the motion. The council approved.
