

# Town of Central

November 10, 1964

The Town Council met Thursday night, November 10, 1964, with the following attending: Mayor Wayne C. Kelley, Councilmen Glenn D. O'Dell, J.L. Martin, R.A. Busha, Jerry B. Lesley, W.J. Wilson, J.R. Herd, Mrs. Maude Chapman, representing the Messenger Paper, Bob Bradley, representing the Greenville News Paper.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

A discussion was held on tapping House Trailers on to water and sewer lines on temporary basis. Mr. Herd made a motion that temporary basis for House trailers tapping on to water and sewer lines be for a thirty (30) day period. Mr. Busha seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mayor Kelley, mentioned that a tractor with ditch digging equipment previously owned by Cole Plumbing & Heating would be for sale and thought that it might be wise for the Town to purchase this equipment provided that it did not exceed \$2,000.00. Mr. Lesley made a motion that if the tractor could be bought for \$2,000.00 for the Town to go ahead and purchase said tractor. Mr. Martin seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

A discussion was held on several dark areas in town limits which are in need of street lights. Mr. Busha made a motion that street lights be installed, near Olin Mann's house on Eaton Street, behind Central Roller Mill, Head Circle, Mr. Wilson seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mr. Martin made a motion that the Town borrow \$2,000.00, from Carolina National Bank for a period of thirty (30) days, rather than take money out of the Savings Account. Mr. Lesley seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Being no futher business the meeting adjourned.
