Those Present: Jack Kennemore, Furman Hopkins, Sr., Troy Porter, George Fowler, Billy Busha, Herbert Thompson, Jr. Mayor H.R. Holladay, St. Supervisor John Head, Chief of Police Harold L. Duncan & Bernie Irwin with Appalachian Council of Governments to explain Business License Rates and duties of a Business Administrator.

Mayor called the meeting to order and gave a report from The Central Planning Commission to change Zoning R-6 to GR for John W. Wallace & Ramsey Rollins. See letter attached. Will have to be advertised 2 weeks.

Motion made by Fowler, 2nd by Kennemore that Mr. F.E. Kirkley be appointed by the Mayor & Council to serve on the Central Planning Commission in the place of Hon. J.L. Brock who has deceased. Motion Carried.

Fire Chief(John Head) invited the Council to the annual Christmas Supper for the Fire Dept. Nov. 29, 1975

Pay to The Pickens County Water & Sewer Authority \$600.00 if money is available.

Mr. Porter & Mr. Ballenger with R.EAA. reported to the Council to enter into an agreement with the Town to remain with REA where power is now located. Will pay a fee of \$250.00. Council defray passage untill next meeting night.

Bernie Irwin gave a report to the council concerning a Business Administrator for the town. The Administrator is hired by the Council and may be fired by the majority of the Council.

Motion by Fowler, seconded by Furman Hopkins to adopt Business Licenses that had been rated on gross receipts for the Town of Central by Bernie Irwin from the Applalachian Council of Governments Office. All council approved with the exception of Jack Kennemore, Motion carried. Police are to see that this ordinance is carried out.

Furman Hopkins is to replace lights in the Central Fire Station.

George Fowler made a request to remove Home Occupation from our Zoning Ordinance, this request was table until a later date.
