MINUTES

Regular Meeting

NOV. 11, 1974

THOSE PRESENT:

Mayor Holladay, George Fowler, Herbert Thompson Jr., Troy Porter, Jack Kennemore, Furman Hopkins, Billy Joe Busha, Chief of Police Harold L. Duncan, St. Supervisor John Head.

The mayor called the meeting to order and the following was in discussion & motion:

- 1) Motion made by Hopkins, 2nd by Kennemore for the Town to write a letter to Southern Railroad requesting that the Underpass be painted by Southern Railways. Motion carried.
- 2) Motion made by Fowler, 2nd by Hopkins for the Town to pay the \$ 424.00 municipal membership dues. Motion carried.
- 3) The mayor read a letter from Hal Garrett requesting that something be done on Gaines St. in front of his house, also Jack Wilson's, dangerous hill.
** Motion made Kennemore, 2nd by Porter to reduce all speed limits to 25 miles per hr., also try to get dangerous hill signs to be placed at the top of the hill. Motion carried.
- 4) Motion made by Fowler, 2nd by Hopkins to purchase a refrigerator to be placed at the South sewer plant for chemicals. Motion carried.
- 5) Motion made by Fowler, 2nd by Busha to have Harwood Beebe Co. to fill out permit. Motion carried.
- 6) Information given to Chief Duncan concerning Ordinancee Books for the Town of Central, have made.
- 7) Mayor read a letter from Jack Dunn's Engineer requesting the Town to furnish a 6 inch water line. Motion made by Fowler, 2nd by Thompson to keep proposal that was passed previously on this matter. Council agreed.
- 8) Motion made by Porter, 2nd by Kennemore to hire D. Chappel to paint markers (St.) on Gaines, Main, & Church St., at \$7.00 per marker. Motion carried.
- 9) Chief Duncan stated to the council that the New Bank that was being built, that the Construction Co. was doing the best they could do under the conditions.
