

Regular Council Meeting November 11, 1985

Mayor Cumbie called the meeting to order.

Invocation by Mr. Harry Holladay.

Minutes of the October 14, 1985 meeting were read. Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Henry Law to adopt. Vote unanimous.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mr. Law--None

Mr. Chaka--Police report given (copy) attached.

Mr. Porter--To get with Mr. Cleo Hendricks concerning condition of sidewalk in front of Mr. Hendrick's house.

Mr. Holladay--Noted that the Recreation banquet was set for December 7 at Central Elementary School.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. Porter--Noted that Meredith Street was paved and possibly Taylor Street by the end of the week.

Mr. Holladay--Motion by Mr. Holladay, second by Mr. Porter to accept the Recreation Policy as amended and the addition of #15 to the regulations.;

The 1984-85 General Fund to reimburse the Recreation Department \$2874.83 for relief of Recreation Department's paying the utility bills (lights, phone, gas). That the REcreation Department write a check to the Central Area Booster Club in the amount of \$1500.00 representing their share of money raised this year.

That the Town of Central, General Fund Reserve Account be responsible for paying the 1985-86 Recreation Department's utility accounts.

Vote was 4 for and 2 against (Mr. Law and Mr. Chaka opposed)

Mr. Randy Gibbs--Zoning request. He did not appear.

Mayor's report:

Mayor Cumbie read letter from Attorney Lindsay concerning Summey Street.

Motion By Frank Chaka, second by Troy Porter to remove sign until the time that the street is deeded to the town, then put sign back up as Summey Street.

Vote was 5 for and 1 against (Mr. Law objected)

(It is noted that Mr. Leon Newman was in agreeance with this motion)

Letter concerning water pipe line across Central Plaza (attached) was read. No formal action at this time.

Motion by Henry Law, second by Frank Chaka to proceed with acquiring right-of-way. Vote unanimous.

Septic tank at First Assembly of God property on Hwy 93. Mr. Leon Newman was recognized. He asked permission to be allowed to put a septic tank on the church property and the lot next door. This request denied.

FRIENDS OF DANIEL request for funds. Motion by Harry Holladay, second by Troy Porter to give \$500. Vote unanimous.

Mayor Cumbie read a letter from Mr Jack Wilson on Eaton Street praising Thad Garrick and his department in help with his sewer problem.

Administrator's report:

Noted the Municipal banquet for November 25, 1985 at Holliday Inn.

Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Henry Law to go into executive session.

Vote unanimous.

Overtime situation discussed. Concensus of council to leave as is and when pending laws are enacted, council will abide.
