November 11, 1991

Mayor Cumbie called the meeting to order.
Invocation by Harry Holladay.

Minutes of the October 14, 1991 meeting were presented. Motion by Lou Robinson, second
by Frank Chaka to approve. Vote was unanimous.

OLD BUSINESS:

Stan Thompson - Public Safety - Question concerning an assistant judge. Herbert Thompson
noted that Tamara Cranford was handling the full load for the present. Mr. Stan
Thompson requested that a meeting be set with John Head before next work session,
preferably on Friday.

Frank Chaka - Finance - Mr. Chaka gave the financial report, noting that items were
under budget to date.

Lou Robinson - Planning - Ms. Robinson reported that our town had joined the S. C.
Downtown Development Association.

Harry Holladay - Recreation - Mr. Holladay reported that the Mites football team wa
in the playoffs this night. Also noted that communication within the Recreation
program needs to be upgraded.

"Doc" Evatt - Streets and Sanitation - Noted that some street lights were out on Main
Street.

NEW BUSINESS:

Stan Thompson - Mr. Thompson reported that Mr. Lee Gamble of Nationwide Insurance Company
is donating a "Sniffer" device for the police department. This device is used for ~~as~~

Frank Chaka - Mr. Chaka requested that Christmas bonus be put on agenda for next work
session. Also, Town's Christmas supper.

Lou Robinson - Ms. Robinson asked for update on old school building. Mayor Cumbie has
been in touch with Tiger Mitchell, but she has not gotten back in touch mayor. The
issue is being pursued.

Administrator's Report:

Mr. Herb Thompson reported that lights along Hwy 93 would likely be at each
intersection and go back later and fill in the gaps. He is to meet with engineers
and do same kind of lighting as Clemson for uniformity. Turn lanes at this end
of 93 discussed. Mr. Thompson reported that the final tie ins on Gaines Street
water line had been made.

Donna Kazia- COG was introduced and explained the preparation she could do for
the town's Policy and Procedure Manual. After discussion a \$400.00 charge for this
service was discussed. Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Stan Thompson to contract
with Ms. Kazia to do the manual with condensed copies for employees included. Vote
was unanimous.

Mayor's Report:

Mayor Cumbie reported that Dr. Bruce Holdorf will be taking over Dr. Barnwell Myers dental practice and he is residing in Central.
First Reading on Annexation Ordinance and Petition for Dr. Claude Rickman, Barney Jones, Ms. Leonard Brank and Frank Warren. Motion by Lou Robinson, second by "Doc" Evatt to annex this property. Vote was unanimous.

A welcome procedure for new businesses was discussed.
Mayor Cumbie reported that Pickens County Transportation Committee would meet at 12:00 Noon on November 25, 1991. Mayor Cumbie and "Doc" Evatt to attend.
DCBG grant status was discussed. No formal granting as of yet. Mayor Cumbie had a phone call and revising of guidelines are being considered. They are looking at the service sector as well as housing sector and an official notification should be forthcoming as to acceptance or not.
