The December regular meeting of the Mayor and Town Council of Central, S. C. was held on the 1st day at 8:30 P. M. and the following were present. G. F. Perry, Mayor; W. A. Gaines, Chief of Police, Councilmembers Grady Berry, Doyle, Elrod, Tom Newton, C. B. Bryan, Bill Wallace.

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor and the first business to come up was our finished audit from Mr. Whitmire. A copy of this audit was given to the Councilmembers.

The Business license for 1953 were discussed at this time. The Mayor passed out a copy of the 1952 ordinance to all Councilmembers and after a study of this the Council agreed to just use last years ordinance with no changes.

Mr. Perry then told the Council that the block in our old truck busted about 2 days before we traded. The Council agreed to take out liability insurance on this truck.

The extra police help was then discussed and it was agreed upon to get Mr. Stone. He is going to work at the Filter Plant and help police on the side. He lives beyond Six Mile. The Council thought about this matter. G. T. Newton thought this to be a good thing. C. B. Bryan thought that we should pay between 10 and 15 dollars, and if we could get him at \$15 take him. This was agreeable with all members.

The Christmas lights were discussed again. The people of the town have seen Duke about the Cost. Mr. Smith called Mr. Perry and Mr. Perry guaranteed up to \$50 on the lights. This was agreeable with the Council.

The meeting then adjourned.
