A regular meeting of the Town Council was held on Tuesday, December 1, 1970 at 7:00 P. M. in lieu of the December 7, 1970 Meeting. Meeting was held at the Town Hall with the following attending: Mayor, H. R. Holladay, Councilmen J. R. Herd, George Fowler, A. B. Cumbie, Jr., Jack Kennemore, Glen D. O'Dell and Herbert Thompson, Jr. Also present for the meeting were the following men representing the Service Stations in Town, Dan Evatt, Buddy Evatt, F. W. Winkler, and Junior Martin.

Parts of the Newly adopted Sewerage Ordinance were read to the Service Station Operators in regards to grease, oil, and etc. going into the sewerage system. Service Station Operators were asked to cooperate with the Town in trying to eliminate these problems, as it makes it impossible for the sewerage treatment plants to function properly with the grease, oil, and etc. going into the system.

Recommendations from the Health Department were read by the Mayor as for cleaning up the Town, such as old junked cars and etc. Also a recommendation from the Health Department on the use of smaller garbage cans or plastic bags was discussed, but no action was taken on this matter.

A discussion was held on the increasing of the Water Rates and a 50% Sewer Charge. Councilman O'Dell made a motion seconded by Councilman Thompson that this increase become effective on the February, 1971 monthly billing. This motion was unanimous.

There was some discussion on the Annexation Election. Councilman Fowler made a motion seconded by Councilman Thompson that this election be held on Tuesday, December 15, 1970. This vote was unanimous.

There was a request from the Central Improvement Club for a donation to help with the expenses of the annual Christmas Parade. After discussion, Councilman Cumbie made a motion seconded by Councilman Herd that the Town donate \$100.00 to the Central Improvement Club for this cause. This vote was unanimous.

Some recommendations read by the Mayor and asked the Council to be thinking about were for the parking spaces on main street to be marked and also to have a school for auxiliary policemen.

Request from Leland Brock and Ramsey Rollins pertaining to Sewerage were brought before the Council. After much discussion on these request, it was agreed to let Councilman Fowler and Councilman Cumbie look into the situation and decide where to run the lines and etc.

The Water situation of T. P. Kelley, C. B. Bryan and Montaine Kay was discussed. A motion was made by Councilman Cumbie for John Head to check into this situation and see what they need on

this water line and to report back to the Council. This motion was seconded by Councilman O'Dell. Vote was unanimously carried.

Councilman Fowler made a motion seconded by Councilman Cumbie to discontinue the \$1.75 charge per month for the fire hydrant for the people in the Rollins-ville Area. This motion was unanimously carried.

There was a report given on Hospitalization Insurance for the Town Employees from the Metropolitan Ins. Co. and also from the Blue Cross-Blue Shield Ins. Co. Councilman O'Dell made a recommendation that we accept the Blue Cross-Blue Shield Plan with the option left up to the employee as to whether he or she wants the Single Plan or the Family Plan with or without the Major Medical Benefits. This vote was unanimous.

Some discussion was held on the Christmas Bonuses for the Town Employees after discussion, Councilman Cumbie made a motion to give each employee a \$60.00 Bonus. Councilman Thompson seconded this motion. Vote was unanimously carried.

No further business was transacted at this meeting.
