The Town Council held their regular meeting Thursday night, December 3, 1965, with the following attending: Mayor W.C. Kelley, Councilmen: Glenn D. O'Dell, R.A. Busha, J.R. Herd, J.L. Martin, Jerry Lesley.

Mayor Kelley presided over the meeting, The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Councilman Lesley gave a report on the Christmas parade to be held on December 3, and stated that a number of unites would be entered, in the parade.

A disucssion was held on buying gas wholesale and having a tank installed for the use of town vehicles. Councilman ^{O'Dell} made a motion that a contract be drawn up with Gulf Oil Co. for the purchase of gas wholesale. Councilman Herd, seconded the motion. The council agreed.

A discussion was held on the purchase of a new truck for the water Dept.. Council Martion made a motion that a new truck be ordered from the Central Purchasing Agency in Columbia for the Water Dept. Councilman O'Dell seconded the motion. The Council voted unamously.

Councilman Busha, made a motion that a shelter be built behind the old jail for the housing of town eqiptment. Councilman Martin made a motion that this subject be tabled until next meeting. Mayor Kelley appointed Councilman Busha & Herd to check on the cost of a shelter.

Being no futher business the meeting adjourned.
