At the regular monthly meeting of the Town Council held December 5, 1955 at 7 P. M. the following were present: Mayor S. C. Carson, Council men Gredy Berry, H. R. Holliday, C. B. Bryson, Earle Crane, Doyle Elrod and Tom Newton. Relatives of Mrs. Winifred Finannon met with the council and asked them to accept an American flag in memory of her husband, this flag to be used as the Town saw fit. H. R. Holliday made a motion that the Town accept this flag, D. B. 2nd this motion and the Council voted unanimously.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and H. R. Holliday made a motion that these minutes be adopted, C. B. Bryson 2nd this motion and the council voted unanimously.

Mayor Carson told the Council that we should have an ordinance concerning gas and that all Mayors of towns in Pickens County were meeting in Easley to discuss this and also revive the County Municipal Association which will be of some help to us.

C. B. Bryson made a motion that G. T. Newton have authority to fix the streets and to deal with the gas company, this motion was 2nd by W. R. Bryson Holliday and the council all agreed upon Mr. Newton having full authority.

Our business license ordinance were discussed and after some talk H. R. Holliday made motion to made changes as per ordinance attached, C. B. Bryson 2nd the motion and the Council voted unanimously.

H. R. Holliday made a motion that all begging on streets or soliciting be stopped, C. B. Bryson made a 2nd to this motion and the Council were in favor of this.

Signs on speed were discussed and Mr. Newton stated that he saw Mr. Powell about these signs. The Council agreed to do away with the 25 MPH signs and try to enforce the 35 MPH.

The meeting then adjourned.
