December 5, 1963

The Town Council met Thursday night, December 5, 1963, with the following attending: Mayor J.A. Cranford, Councilmen C.B. Bryan, H.M. Brooks, J.L. Martin, R.A. Busha, W.J. Wilson, and Mrs. Maude Chapman, representing the Messenger Paper.

Mr. Cranford mentioned that he thought Mr. Reams should be reimbursed for expenses which he had paid while working in North Carolina. Mr. Busha made a motion that he be given a check for \$25.00 to cover expenses. Mr. Brooks seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mr. Wilson made a motion that Mr. R.E. Holcombe be reimbursed the amount of \$1.50 for repair on sewer line, and that no other bills be paid on repair other than ones authorized to be done. Mr. Bryan seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

A discussion was held on having each merchant to have a garbage bin behind stores in order to solve the problem of having trash scattered. Mr. Cranford said that he had ask Mr. Carson to give an estimate on the cost of the bins which would be available at the next meeting night.

Mr. Hill from Easley was present to discuss cleaning the raw water line from the Filterplant to the Creek. No decision was made on having this work done.

Mr. Newton, of Clemson Lumber Co., was also present to discuss the matter of the Town running water to their property which is known as Pressley Acres. No answer could be given to Mr. Newton until futher checking the cost of cleaning the raw water line.

Plans for a New Town Hall were futher discussed. Mr. Cranford said that he had not been able to check about plans but would try to have this done by next meeting.



Mr. Martin mentioned that Mr. Garvin Johnson would like to rent the Filterplant for a maintenance shop. No decision was made on this.
