The Town Council met December 6, 1962, with the following attending: Mayor J.A. Cranford, Councilmen W.J. Wilson, J.L. Martin, C.B. Bryan, R.A. Busha, and A.R. Cureton. Bob Brady with the Greenville News was also present.

A discussion was held on the property owned by the Town near 18 Mile Creek where the water pump is located. R.T. Martin had ask to buy the property. The Council decided not to sell the property at this time, but give him permission to use this property until such time as a decision can be made to sell. Mr. Bryan made a motion that an agreement to this effect be drawn up. Mr. Busha seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

The Gabbage Truck being in need of two new tires and other tires on truck recapped was discussed. Mr. Busha made a motion that the two new tires be bought from J.L. Martin and the other tires on truck be recapped. A.R. Cureton seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

A discussion was held on drawing up an ordinance on illegal fire works being bought, having in possession, sold and ~~being~~ shot within the city limits. The Council agreed to go along with the State Law until this Ordinance is drawn up. Mr. Wilson made a motion to this effect. Mr. Bryan seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Correcting the error of the telephone number for the Fire Dept., which was made by the Telephone Co. was discussed. Mr. Cureton said that he would have his Scouts to go from house to house and change this number if Mr. Estees agreed for them to do so. It was decided that Mr. Estees be contacted about this.

Discussions were held on the following but not action taken. Heater for the Town jail, Sewer for residents on West Main St.

Being no futher business the meeting adjourned.
